The bank moved into their new building on January 1, 1911. It was the central bank for several branches in northern Montana including Galata, Concord, Dunkirk, Brady, Collins, and Dutton. In 1912, the county attorney, coroner, assessor, and superintendent of schools were all located here because of a shortage of space. Rent was \$210 per month. The Havre National Bank did not remain at this location long, however, as they relocated to the old Citizen's Bank location at 228 First Street in 1913."/>

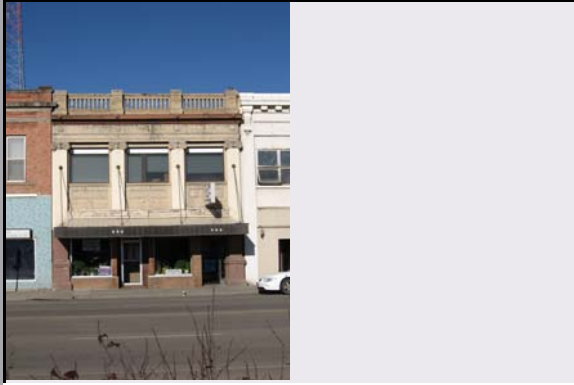
