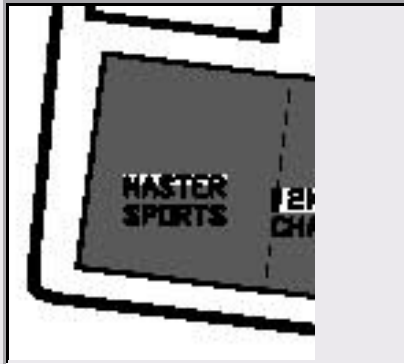

Historical Significance

in 1948 and remained there until 1969 when they moved to Second Avenue. In 1973, Bob Evans opened Master Sports which has been here ever since.

**Integrity** Despite alterations to the first story, the Buffalo Building/Master Sports retains sufficient integrity to convey its significant historic and architectural associations.

**Statement of Significance** This building is historically significant for its associations with the early commercial development of Havre, as one of the town's early clothing stores, a saloon, drug store, and dry goods store. The building has also been the location of the sporting goods store for 35 years. The building figures prominently on the constructed landscape as an anchor for the corner of First Street and Third Avenue. It gains additional significance for its association with prominent architect George Shanley.
